- School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA)

  - Focus on literacy

  - Kellogg Bulldogs PAWS (Practice Kindness, Appreciate Diversity, Work hard, Stay Safe)
- Speak up Now
- "The Dream Team" (staff described by parents)

## 4. Superintendent's Message - Dr. Galindo-Roybal

Dr. Galindo-Roybal asked the committee to name an educator who made a difference in their lives.

She shared her message about literacy and how the power of belief creates a future of hope. She talked about:

- Dr. Victor Rios' message
- Collective Efficacy = Highest impact on student learning
- Professional Learning Communities (PLC)
- Book: Belonging Through a Culture of Dignity by Floyd Cobb and John Krownapple (Physiological, Safety, Belonging, Achievement, Self-Actualization)
- Diversity, equity and inclusion and the connection to reading and literacy
  - Anti-literacy laws in the United States
  - Reading Is the gateway to access and opportunity
  - Science of Reading, phonics and foundational skills

## 5. The committee engaged in a conversation about the following topics:

- California has the second lowest literacy rate, at 71.6%.
- State law now requires schools to screen for dyslexia characteristics, however, dyslexia is a medical diagnosis.
